

COVID-19 Vaccine Side Effects

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You may experience:

- Pain, redness, or swelling on the arm where you got the shot
- Tiredness
- Headache
- Muscle pain
- Chills
- Fever
- Nausea

Ways to Relieve Side Effects:

To reduce discomfort where you got the shot:

- Apply a clean, cool, wet washcloth
- Use or exercise your arm

Side effects should go away in a few days!

To reduce discomfort from fever:

- Drink plenty of fluids
- Dress lightly
- Consider over-the-counter medicine, such as Advil or Tylenol

You should call a doctor if:

- Redness or tenderness where you got the shot worsen after 24 hours
- Side effects are worrying you or do not seem to be going away after a few days
