- Make sure your vaccinations are up to date





The map at right shows the percentage of residents in Benton County and its neighboring counties who had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine as of May 1, 2022.

At 49.4%, Benton County ranks 48th in Tennessee for vaccinations.

Meigs, the highest-ranked county in TN, has a 76.1% vaccination rate.

77.7% of Americans have received at least one dose.
