

# COVID-19 Vaccine FAQs:



## 1 Do I need to show identification to get vaccinated?

No. You don't need to have a driver's license or health insurance to get a vaccine.

## 2 Why am I asked about my race and ethnicity?

You may be asked about your race and ethnicity to help make sure vaccines are distributed fairly. The government cannot use your information for immigration enforcement.

## 3 Where can I get vaccinated?

You can get vaccinated at Walgreens and CVS pharmacies without an appointment. Vaccines are also available at doctor's offices, hospitals, and county health departments.
