Hepatitis A

One dose for unvaccinated adults Hepatitis A is a liver disease that can be spread between

people

Hepatitis B

One dose for adults 19-59 years of age, and adults 60+ with Hepatitis B risk factors

> Hepatitis B is a liver disease that can be spread between people

COVID-19

One yearly booster dose after initial vaccination Safely prevents COVID-19 infection

HPV

Two doses for unvaccinated adults aged 18-26 Prevents cancercausing infections and precancers

Shingles

Two doses for adults 50+

If you have had chickenpox before, it can reappear as shingles later

Tetanus (DTaP)

every 10 years Protects against and whooping
