# Complete P+CPTED Training: Introduction



## Overview

This introductory session is designed to kick-off a three-part program to equip Extension professionals with the knowledge, skills and tools to implement a P+CPTED project in a community they are working within. A commitment to all three pieces of this program is not required. If you just want to come to this introductory session, you are welcome.

P+CPTED or Placemaking + Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design focuses on the relationship between the physical environment and criminal opportunity. It equips communities to co-develop strategies that promote quality of life characteristics while deterring crime at the same time. This approach is ideal for communities or neighborhoods that have low-trust environments with law enforcements and municipalities with thinly stretched budgets that haven't seen an improvement in crime with increased police presence.
