



# Complete P+CPTED Training Program



## Overview

This three-part program is designed to equip Extension professionals with the knowledge, skills and tools to implement a P+CPTED project in a community they are working within. P+CPTED or Placemaking + Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design focuses on the relationship between the physical environment and criminal opportunity. It equips communities to co-develop strategies that promote quality of life characteristics while deterring crime at the same time. This approach is ideal for communities or neighborhoods that have low-trust environments with police and municipalities with thinly stretched budgets that haven't seen an improvement in crime with increased police presence.
