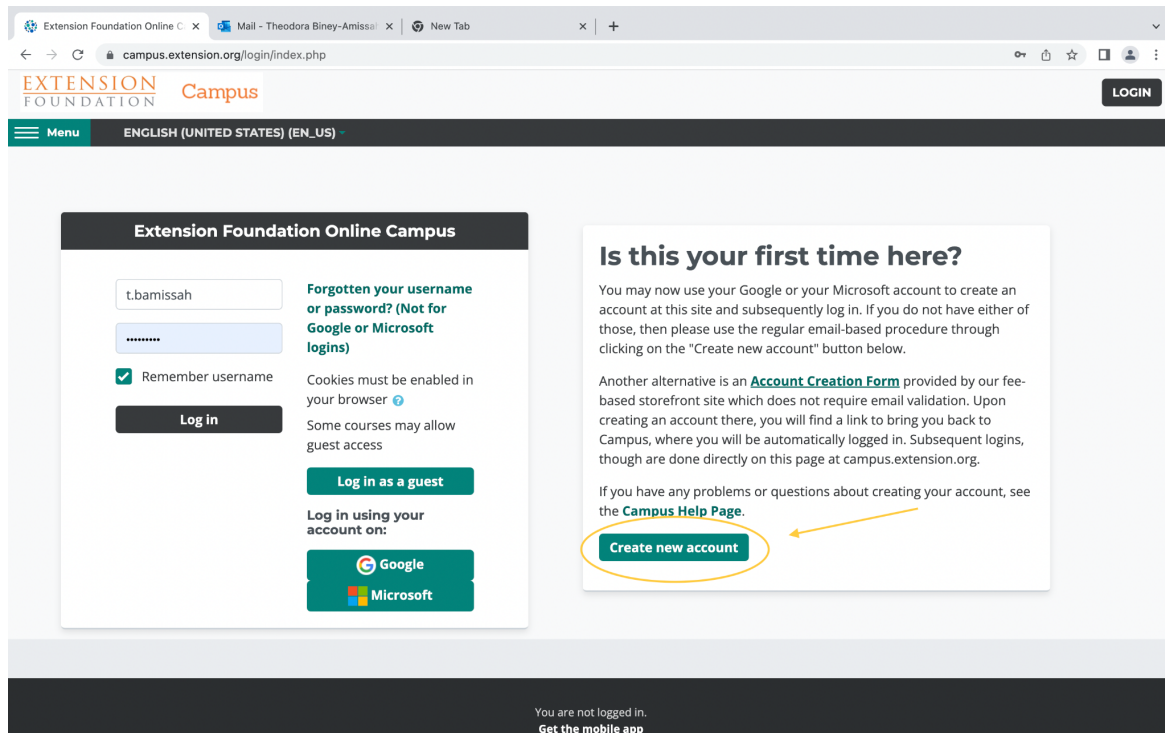
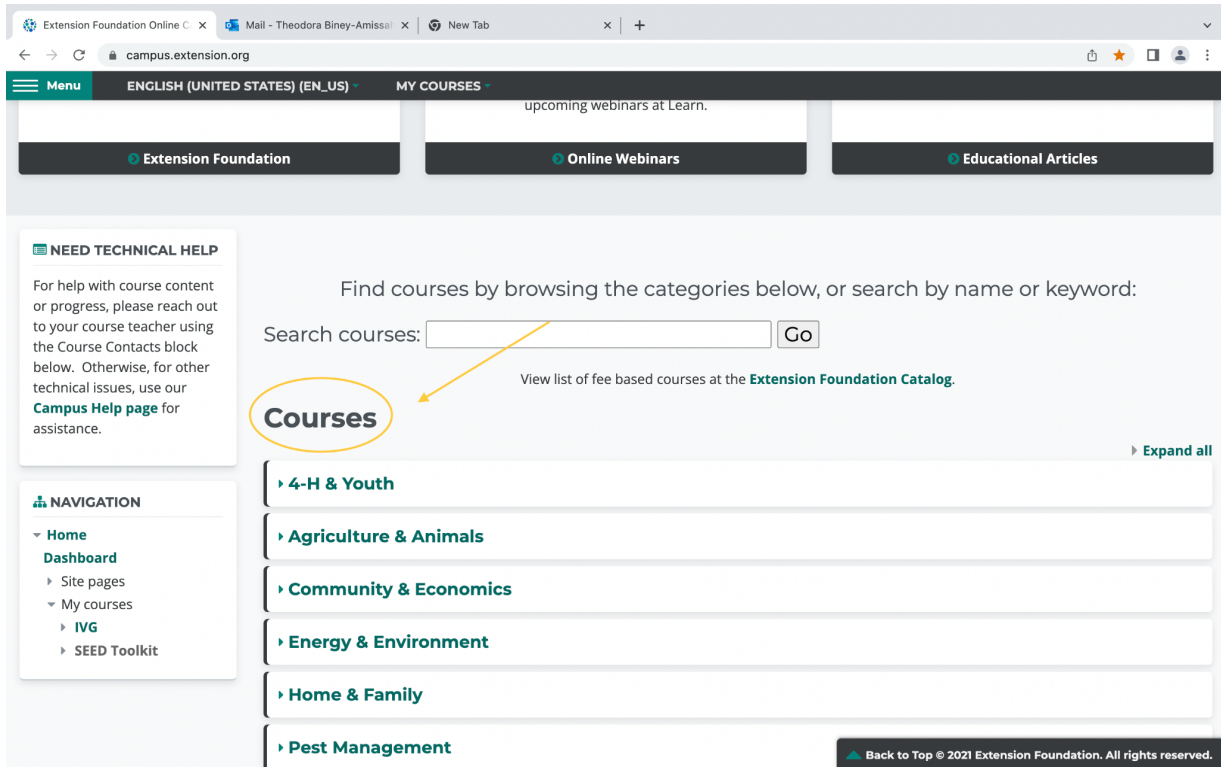


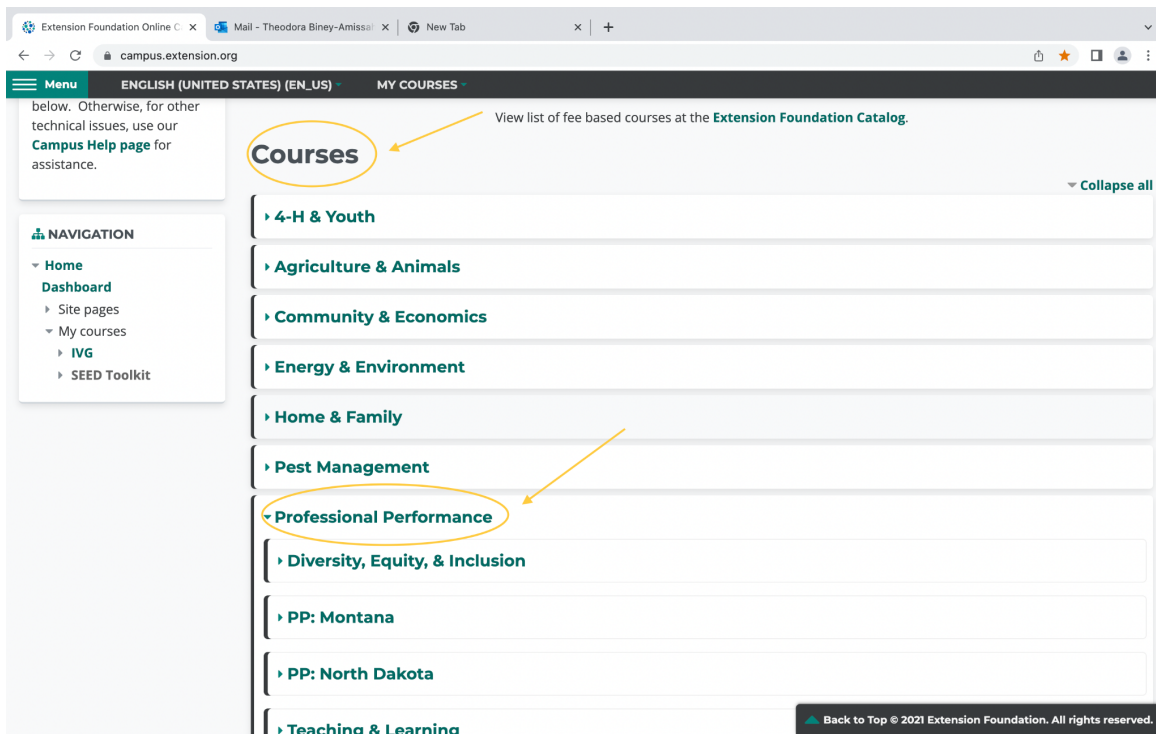
1. Create an account on Extension Foundation's Online Campus - <https://campus.extension.org/>
